

CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

a. Kalugmanan, Manolo Fortich, Bukidnon

The thrust of A Brown Company, Inc. to support and assist the community in areas where it has a project leads ABCI to a harmonious relationship with the Indigenous Talaandig Community of Barangay Kalugmanan, Manolo Fortich, Bukidnon. The Talaandig Tribal Council of Elders spearhead the Indigenous Peoples (IP's) Community in the area.

Since 2004 an Annual Appeasement Ritual is conducted every February of each year. This is a very important cultural practice of the IPs, which has been of great value to them. During this time also, the company shares to the IPs the following:

1. Annual Medical Assistance worth -P- 10,000.00
2. Rubber boots, rain coats and flashlights for the Tribal Guards
3. Annual Royalty Fee of -P- 20,000.00 which will be used for livelihood projects of the Tribal Community

Aside from the above-mentioned support, the company assists in the following:

1. Rehabilitation of a portion of the provincial road that is situated in the said barangay.
2. Yearly barangay activities (e.g. Sports related, fiesta activities and the like)
3. 10 hectare Rainforestation Project at Mount Kitanglad which cost is -P-100,000.00/ year for three years or a total of -P- 300,000.00.

Further, the company actively support the annual activity of all Barangays situated around Mt. Kitanglad dubbed as "ALDAW TE KITANGLAD" by providing financial support and transportation for the Indigenous Peoples Community from Barangay Kalugmanan and Barangay Dahilayan.
